

Help Guide to buying spares for your Cooper Pegler Sprayer

Whilst many parts are common between all Cooper Pegler sprayers (for example the lance and triggers), many are not, so it is imperative that you know which type of sprayer you have before you order.

Due to the number of incorrectly ordered parts we have put together this guide that you may find helpful.

Please consult this and check your sprayer before you order.

1. Look at your sprayer.

If your sprayer looks like one in the pictures below, then it is a **Classic type sprayer** (it does not matter whether it is 15litre or 20 litre, parts are the same). The defining feature of the Classic sprayer is that the lid is in the centre.

2. Is your sprayer like either of these? If yes,

The parts that you need for your sprayer are found here:

If no, then please continue.

3. Is your sprayer like the ones below?

The defining feature is that the lid is off to the side (off-centre).

If your sprayer is like these, then it is a **Series 2000 type sprayer**. (again, it does not matter whether it is a 15litre or 20litre as parts are the same)
